

Zeping Cai (Soprano)



Professor Zeping Cai enjoys a distinguished career as a renowned soprano and educator. She has formerly served as Chair of Voice Department and academic advisor of graduate student at Music College in Shanghai Normal University. Professor Cai is a member of National Musician Association of China as well as a member of MTAC and NATS of United States.

Professor Cai has given numerous acclaimed solo recitals in Shanghai, Tokyo, Salt Lake City and San Diego, and toured south-east Asia and United States. She sang arias and title songs for Chinese movies and TV series, and appeared as lead singer at national and international concerts in China. Her award highlights include China's MTV gold medalist, 10<sup>th</sup> Star Light Award, Shanghai Spring International Festival Soprano Soloist Award, and 1<sup>st</sup> Oriental Who's Who Accomplishment Award. As a recording artist, she has also released many albums.

Professor Cai is highly esteemed by Southern California community and received a Certificate of Honor from the City of Los Angeles. Since taking up permanent resident in San Diego in 2004, she has performed at the famous Walt Disney Concert Hall and Kodak Theater.

Professor Cai has published numerous voice text books and music theory theses. Nominated as China's Established Contemporary Educator and Scholar, Professor Cai possesses more than twenty years of teaching experience. She co-founded Primo Music Institute with Professor SiFang Shen specializing in voice, piano and music theory lessons. The institute gives regular student singing and piano recitals, and sponsors California MTAC Music Certification programs.
